THE NOTTINGHAM INQUIRY

SECOND WITNESS STATEMENT OF PC DAVID MYERS

I, DAVID MYERS, will state as follow: -

1. My name is David Myers, I am a Police Officer, currently serving with Nottinghamshire Police.
2. This statement is made to assist the Nottingham Inquiry (the "Inquiry") with the matters set out in a Rule 9 Request dated 27th June 2025 ("the Request") and is supplemental to my first statement made in response to that request and dated 31 October 2025 (WITN0042001).

3. In making this statement, I have refreshed my memory by reading;
 - a. NICHE Occurrence 21000512528 (URN: NGPF0000027)
 - b. Case File 31CF1215321 (URN: NGPF0000017)
 - c. NICHE Occurrence 22000554223 (URN: NGPF0006093).

4. I have further reviewed Task Number T2204067850, which was allocated to me in relation to (URN: NGPF0006093) this being the NICHE Occurrence that was generated in relation to Calocane failing to appear at Court on 22nd September 2022 for the offence of Assaulting an Emergency Worker.

5. I now produce to the Inquiry the NICHE Task details from each of URN: NGPF0000027, URN: NGPF0000017 and URN: NGPF0006093 as follows:
 - a. Task Log for 21000512528 from URN: NGPF0000027 – (NGPF0010629)
 - b. Task Log for 31CF1215321 from URN: NGPF0000017 – (NGPF0010630)
 - c. Task Log for 22000554223 from URN: NGPF0006093 – (NGPF0010630)

6. I initially believed that on 30th September 2022, I received Task Number T2204067850 (URN: NGPF000006093). This was a 'low priority' task which stated that Calocane had failed to appear at Court on 22nd September 2022 and a warrant was to be issued in due course for his arrest for the said failure to appear.

7. When I viewed the main page of the task in the Tasks menu of NICHE as it appears on URN: NGPF000006093 it appears to show that the task was assigned to me on 23rd September 2022. Due to the length of time between this date and providing my previous statement, I believed (at the time of submitted my previous statement) that this was the case.
8. Upon reviewing the, Task Log for 22000554223 (NGPF0010630), I have now become aware that inside each Task on NICHE, there is an Activity Log which shows in chronological order the dates, times, initiator and assigned officer for that task. It also shows what actions a person has conducted on that task and also shows if a task is re-allocated to another officer.
9. Upon reviewing the activity log contained within Task Number T2204067850 (NGPF0010630) 30th September 2022 was actually the due date for when that particular task should have been completed.
10. The Activity Log on Task Number T2204067850 which is part of exhibit NGPF0010630, shows that the task was in fact assigned to PC Sutton on 23rd September 2022. PC Sutton was the recording officer for URN: NGPF0000027. I now believe, however, that PC Sutton was absent from duty at that time.

11. Task Number T2204067850 (NGPF0010630) was then re-allocated by PC 3998 Sutton to me on 20th January 2023.

12. On 20th January 2023, upon seeing that Task Number T2204067850 (NGPF0010630) had been allocated to me, I performed a Police National Computer (PNC) check on Valdo Calocane, in order to clarify whether he was still wanted for failing to attend Court on 22nd September 2022. The front page of Valdo Calocane's PNC report showed that he was still wanted for failing to attend Court.

13. Also on 20th January 2023, I sent an Email to PC Pritchard making him aware that I had just received the task stating that Calocane was wanted for failing to attend Court for the assault on him, and I stated if Valdo Calocane was still wanted by the following week, then we (the City Centre Operation Reacher team) could try and locate him (URN: NGPF0005699).

14. No specific task was sent to me requesting me to make an arrest attempt and it is my belief that the specific NICHE Occurrence for Valdo Calocane failing to attend Court (URN: NGPF0006093) would have been allocated to the NICHE Wanted Inbox for the Policing area which Valdo Calocane resided in when the warrant was issued (this being the Radford Road Police Station area).

15. Due to Task Number T2204067850 (NGPF0010630) being a 'low priority' one and for my 'information only', I marked the task as 'completed' on 26th January 2023.

16. On 12th February 2026 I became aware of the fact that it appears that I was re-allocated Task Number T2204067850 (NGPF0010630) on 20th January 2023 rather than it being allocated to me since its creation on 23rd September 2022. I emailed the NICHE Administration Team asking them to confirm when I was allocated the task; they confirmed that Task Number T2204067850 (NGPF0010630) was not sent to me in September 2022 and was only sent to me in January 2023 when it was re-assigned by PC Sutton. I have exhibited the email chain as NGPF0010624.

17. To further verify whether I could or should have been aware of the fact that Valdo Calocane was wanted on warrant before 20th January 2023, I asked my current Sergeant, DS Flint, whether a PNC (Police National Computer) Transaction Enquiry could be completed on Valdo Calocane's details for the period 22nd September 2022 to 20th January 2023 (these being the dates that Calocane Failed to appear at Court and the date when Task Number T2204067850 (NGPF0010630) was re-allocated to me). I exhibit the email to DS Flint as NGPF0010626.

18. For the Transaction Enquiry to be completed correctly and without error, I emailed the Nottinghamshire Police PNC Bureau and requested that they

complete the Transaction Enquiry on my behalf. I have exhibited the email chain with the PNC Bureau as NGPF0010626.

19. The information I was provided with by the PNC Bureau was that three PNC checks were completed on Valdo Calocane between 22nd September 2022 and 22 January 2023. The first two were on 23rd and 24th September 2022 when the warrant was being added to Valdo Calocane's PNC record to show him as wanted. The third transaction was on 20th January 2023 when I completed a 'failure to appear' enquiry. I exhibit the Transaction Enquiry Print as NGPF0010627.

20. To the best of my knowledge, I was not aware that Valdo Calocane was wanted for failing to appear at Court on 22nd September 2022 before I conducted PNC enquiries on him on 20th January 2023.
