FIRST WITNESS STATEMENT OF DR CHARLOTTE LISA JOHN

I, DR CHARLOTTE LISA JOHN, will say as follows: -

INTRODUCTION

1. I am a Partner at St Thomas Surgery. I qualified as a doctor from Southampton Medical School in 2000 and qualified as a General Practitioner in 2004 when I also moved back to Pembrokeshire. I worked as a locum and salaried GP until 2010/2011 when I took up a position with St Thomas Surgery becoming a GP partner in 2012. I have worked for the practice in the capacity of GP partner for the past 14 years with a special interest in minor surgery and joint injections.
2. This witness statement is made to assist the Nottingham Inquiry (the "**Inquiry**") with the matters set out in the Rule 9 Request dated 22 APRIL 2026 (the "**Request**").

- I have been asked to 'set out comprehensively any interactions or dealings with VC'. Specifically I have been asked to confirm whether VC ever presented to me or any other GP at my practice with mental health related signs or symptoms. I confirm that during his time as a patient with our surgery VC did not present with any mental health issues. I have also been asked to state whether I or any other GP at the practice was ever concerned that VC was or might be suffering mental health related symptoms. I note that nothing relating to this has been documented in VC's electronic notes held by us and previously shared with the Inquiry.
