THE NOTTINGHAM INQUIRY

FIRST WITNESS STATEMENT OF DETECTIVE INSPECTOR TREVOR PLUMB

I, Trevor Plumb, will say as follows: -

Introduction

1. I have been a police officer within the Metropolitan Police Service (MPS) for over 25 years. I am currently the Threat Assessment Intelligence Lead at FTAC (Fixated Threat Assessment Centre) which is a joint NHS/police unit in London which assesses and manages risks to prominent individuals from people with serious mental health conditions. I have held this role for over 3 and half years. Prior to this role, I led the Metropolitan Police Public Order Intelligence Unit, identifying and assessing criminality at protests to support appropriate public order and delivering the public safety policing response. I have had experience assessing local, national and international intelligence and participating in relevant investigations for more than 10 years.

2. This statement is made to assist the Nottingham Inquiry (the "Inquiry") with a Rule 9 request for information regarding Valdo Calocane's whereabouts in June 2023. In particular, the MPS has been asked whether it holds records regarding Mr Calocane spending time at a friend's house in Lewisham from 11-12 June 2023, during which time an altercation involving a knife may have occurred. The address given to search against was GRO-B Fordel Road, London SE6 1XS.

Background

3. I understand that In July of this year, the Inquiry Review and Support Command (IRSC) based at Cobalt Square in London SW8RSC were asked to assist with the above request, having already been asked to provide information regarding an MPS incident on 31st May 2021 and involving Mr Valdo CALOCANE.
4. I am aware that searches were undertaken by IRSC researching the Integrated Information Platform (IIP) and the Police National Database (PND). IIP is a search engine that is used within the MPS. It is all encompassing in that it carries out a general search across many systems including MPS Crime recording information systems (CRIS - where reports of crime are created and stored providing a CRIS reference number), Crimint, which was the previous MPS intelligence system used to create, assess, develop and share intelligence, Custody records detailing the actions and events in relation to arrested/detained persons at a police station, and Computer Aided Despatch (CAD) which details emergency calls or requests raised to the MPS. PND is a repository of multiple national police crime records and intelligence, and allows police to search across a number of 'selectors' which include names,

addresses, etc across all police forces in the UK. Searches were undertaken covering the address given for the whole of June 2023.

5. No recorded intelligence was found within MPS records matching the exact incident as described by the inquiry. It was possible to identify one single PND Record. It was of minimal information dated 14/06/2023 which gave a location of [GRO-B] FORDEL ROAD SE6 1XS and nothing else. No names were mentioned on the record, it was shown as an intelligence record originating from Nottingham Police. I attach this as WITN0078002.
6. On 4th August 2025, officers from SO15 were tasked with assisting IRSC by carrying out further searches on the requested intelligence regarding an incident involving a knife and [GRO-B] Fordel Road SE6. SO15 is a specialist branch of the MPS who have access to intelligence not available to IRSC.
7. SO15 conducted a wider search of a 24 hour period either side of 12 June 2023 around the location specified by the Inquiry. Standard searches were conducted but on the historic computer aided despatch (CAD) system (due to how far back this request was for) specifically relating to Lewisham Borough, where the address is located and with specific type codes regarding violence against the person, suspicious circumstances, anti-social behaviour and knife/bladed article. Again, searches found no MPS records of the specific incident on the date or location given by the Inquiry.
8. A wider search of the date and location resulted in the Integrated Information Platform (IIP) identifying a knife point robbery had taken place on 10th June

2023 with a named suspect (not Valdo CALOCANE) whose last known address had been [GRO-B] Fordel Road, SE6. It also showed that on 11th June 2023 an unrelated road rage/public order offence was reported with the suspect vehicle shown registered to a company at [GRO-B] Fordel Road, SE6.

9. While the above searches were not conducted by me personally, I assisted the IRSC by requesting that officers from SO15 conducted the further searches.
