### FIRST WITNESS STATEMENT OF INSP MARK STANLEY

---

I, MARK PAUL STANLEY, will say as follows: -

1. I am a Police Inspector in Nottinghamshire Police currently stationed at Sherwood Lodge, Joint Force Headquarters.
2. This witness statement is made to assist the Nottingham Inquiry (the "**Inquiry**") with the matters set out in the Rule 9 Request dated 9<sup>th</sup> February 2026 (the "**Request**").
3. My current role, which I commenced in November 2024, is Head of Vehicle Fleet for Nottinghamshire Police. Nottinghamshire Police has approximately 620 vehicles, both marked and unmarked, and includes a variety of off road and on road vehicles.
4. I have been asked to confirm the reasons why dashcam footage from police vehicles does not appear to include audio.

5. The decision to implement the current dashcam system was taken prior to my commencement in the role.
6. I can confirm that the system currently fitted to Nottinghamshire Police vehicles only records video and not audio.
7. I can say that there is no national requirement or standard in relation to the fitting of audio visual equipment to police vehicles.
