THE NOTTINGHAM INQUIRY

FIRST WITNESS STATEMENT OF SUPERINTENDENT PAUL BURROWS

I, Paul Burrows, will say as follows:

- 1 This witness statement is made to assist the Nottingham Inquiry (the “**Inquiry**”) with the matters set out in the Rule 9 Request dated 30 January 2026 (the “**Request**”)

- 2 I am Superintendent Paul Burrows. I am the Deputy Head of Corporate Services in Nottinghamshire Police. I held this position on the 13th June 2023 and continue to do so at the date of writing this statement.

- 3 **Requirement**
I have been asked to provide the following information:
 - 3.1 an assurance that all relevant policies have been disclosed in addition to those already submitted to the Inquiry. This includes policies that were in

operation, or otherwise followed by, Nottinghamshire Police at the time of VC's attacks in relation to the following areas:

- a. The National Decision Model (NDM)
- b. The Joint Decision Model (JDM)
- c. Responses to incidents, including:
 - i. Major/critical incident management
 - ii. Police pursuits
 - iii. Marauding terrorist firearms attacks
 - iv. Operation Plato
 - v. Response plans (including gold strategy plans)
 - vi. The activation of a Force Command Module Plan and/or Strategic Coordination Centre (or similar)
 - vii. Generic response plans
- d. Procedures/policies for armed response vehicles ("ARVs) and firearms officers/commanders.
- e. Structural and organisations policies/procedures relating to the following teams/units (or similar):
 - i. Major investigation team
 - ii. Counter terrorism unit
 - iii. Counter Terrorism Security Advisers ("CTSAs")
 - iv. East Midlands Special Operations Unit
 - v. Specialist Operations Branch
 - vi. Firearms Unit
 - vii. Firearms Support Teams
- f. Talk groups and telephony.

g. Command structures, including those applicable to:

i. Command in a critical and/or major incident

ii. Multi-Agency command and control

(While the request is for Policies, I have also reviewed Procedures and Guidance documents. Procedures and Guidance documents are written to support to delivery of the relevant Policy.)

3.2 to disclose any outstanding policies relevant to any of the matters set out at paragraph 3.1 above, and which have not yet been disclosed.

3.3 to provide a brief statement explaining the extent to which the matters set out at paragraph 3.1 are covered by policies or documents that Nottinghamshire Police have already disclosed to the Inquiry and explain which disclosed policies cover which of the areas set out above.

4. For completeness I have recorded a brief statement explaining the extent to which the matters set out at paragraph 3.1 are covered by policies or documents that Nottinghamshire Police have not previously disclosed to the Inquiry.

5. **Statement on the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI)**

5.1 Nottinghamshire Police have 289 Policies and Procedures. The majority of these had a Version that was operational on the relevant date. A small

number of policies have been written after the relevant date; these have not been reviewed as being outside the scope of this statement.

5.2 These Policies and Procedures cover the business response to an 'incident' or 'managerial requirement'. These 'incidents and 'requirements' extend from those already disclosed, to those relating to, for example, Human Resources managerial practices, training protocols, corporate processes and operational responses.

5.3 AI, in the form of Microsoft CoPilot, was used to undertake the background work to enable me to record this statement within the set timescale. With 289 documents to review this was, I took the view, the only way in which this task could be completed.

5.4 I used AI in the following way:

- i. Each of the previously disclosed Policies, Procedures and Documents were cross reference to the requirements in paragraph (3.1) to establish whether there was an 'Engagement'.
- ii. Prompt 1 (Para 4.5) was inputted into Copilot and pointed at the previously disclosed document. This work was undertaken by a single officer working to support me.
- iii. The Copilot output was then sent to me for review.

- iv. I reviewed each record produced by the AI tool and checked it against the original document. This check involved my ensuring the page identified in the AI output as being engaged, was accurate and the information recorded as being within the document, was recorded.
- v. Having reviewed and ensured the output was accurate, I amended the document as required (this included removing hyperlinks to the policy) and then recorded the document with a separate exhibit number.
- vi. I left prompt information in the document as appropriate. This information is frequently recorded as 'I'. 'I' invariably relates to AI speaking. This is, I take the view, obvious on each occasion.
- vii. Any engagements with the requirements are recorded in Tables 1 and 2 below.
- viii. The same process was used to review every previously undisclosed Policy, Procedure and Guidance document that existed in the force on the relevant date; or adjacent (prior) to the relevant date if the specific document couldn't be found.
- ix. Due to the volume of documents needing review, a team of Nottinghamshire Police staff were tasked to review these previously non-disclosed policies for engagement against 3.1, again using Copilot.

- x. Prompt 2 (Para 4.6) was inputted into Copilot and pointed at the previously un-disclosed document.
- xi. The Copilot output was then sent to me electronically for review using SharePoint.
- xii. I reviewed each record produced by the AI tool and checked it against the original document. This check involved my ensuring the page identified in the AI output as being engaged, was accurate and the information recorded as being within the document, was recorded.
- xiii. I left prompt information in the document as appropriate. This information is frequently recorded as 'I'. 'I' invariably relates to AI speaking. This is, I take the view, obvious on each occasion.
- xiv. If a new policy was written post the relevant date this is not evidenced, though it was reviewed.
- xv. If a policy was updated post the relevant date the one being worked to, on the relevant date, was reviewed.
- xvi. Where a match or 'Engagement' is identified this was again, as per xii above, reviewed. I checked the output against the original document to determine whether the Rule 9 requirements (3.1) were met for disclosure.

- xvii. Where no-engagement was identified by Copilot, but I considered one could reasonably have been expected, and it seemed relevant to the tenet of the Inquiry I chose to exhibit the document.
- xviii. Any Engagements with the requirements of 3.1 are recorded in Tables 3 and 4 below (Para 8.1 and 8.2).
- xix. All new previously undisclosed policies and procedures are exhibited as per section 9 and 11 below.
- xx. In Tables 1-6 and in my recording of engagements; I identified during my review of the Copilot output, that some requirements for 3.1 were partially engaged. I only record engagements that were, in my opinion, germane to matters in hand.

5.5 AI Prompt 1 to identify if any previously disclosed policies meet the requirement for disclosure

Review the attached previously disclosed policy / procedure / document and tabulate where and record how this policy engages with any of the following requirements. Do this using the language of the policy in UK English. I also need specific page numbers of where engagement with the policy / procedure / document takes place. If there are sub-policies within the policy / procedure / document name these and the age of the point of engagement. Provide a document that is one table that includes both the engaged and not engaged and keep the lettering system of the requirements.

Do not hallucinate, make up links or create links that do not exist, do not guess only identify links that are verifiable.

The list in paragraph 3.1 was then appended; this is not included to prevent repetition.

5.6 AI Prompt 2 to identify if any non-disclosed policies meet the requirement for disclosure

Review the attached policy / procedure / document and tabulate where and record how this policy engages with any of the following requirements. Do this using the language of the policy / procedure / document in UK English. I also need specific page numbers of where engagement with the policy / procedure / document takes place. If there are sub-policies within the policy / procedure / document name these and the age of the point of engagement. Provide a document that is one table that includes both the engaged and not engaged and keep the lettering system of the requirements. Do not hallucinate, make up links or create links that do not exist, do not guess only identify links that are verifiable.

The list in paragraph 3.1 was then appended; this is not included to prevent repetition.

6 Methodology

6.1 The following methodology was used to ensure compliance with the requirement. This section outlines the procedure used beyond the AI

process recorded in Section 4 above. It relates to both previously disclosed and undisclosed documents.

- 6.2 A full list of Nottinghamshire Police Policies and Procedures was obtained.
- 6.3 Those being worked to on the relevant date were identified.
- 6.4 If a specific Policy or Procedure current on the relevant date was not located, I assessed the reasons why and decided which document should be reviewed.
- 6.5 When documents were not found to be current this was usually because a 'Review' date had expired, and the Policy had not been recorded as being updated. In this instance (as per section 4 above), the Policy / Procedure most recent and prior to the relevant date was reviewed – the date of this policy is recorded in the exhibits. On two occasions, as recorded below, the policy holder had deleted the Version in use on the relevant date. In these instances, the prior Version was used.
- 6.6 As per section 4 relating to the use of AI, the recorded Policy/ Procedure was entered into CoPilot to establish any match with the requirements of paragraph 3.1.

6.7 The specifics of how the team I directed worked to record policies was as follows:

- i. every policy, procedure and guidance document the force holds was identified. There were 289.
- ii. In several instances multiple versions of these documents were held, so the one current at the time of the relevant date was used. If a policy was first written post this date it was not considered for disclosure.
- iii. If there was no policy current on the relevant date, the one prior to the date was reviewed on the presumption that this was the one being worked to at the time.
- iv. The AI prompt I wrote for previously undisclosed policies was deployed (Prompt 2) as per Section 4.
- v. The policy and the output were then copied into a specific SharePoint page set up for the purpose of my writing this statement.

6 folders used within this SharePoint:

1. All (workspace): where all documents for review were held
2. Not engaged – this folder was used by the team to drop a file if, in their view following the CoPilot search, the document didn't engage the requirements of the Inquiry (3.1).

3. Engaged - this folder is where the team member dropped a file if, in their view following the CoPilot search, the document did engage the requirements of the Inquiry.
- vi. I then reviewed all the files – containing the relevant documents in these 2 folders (2 and 3). Based upon this review I moved the documents into 1 of 2 further files:
4. 'Paul to sort for disclose' – these were documents that needed disclosing and would require me to exhibit the policy / procedure / document and review the CoPilot output, or,
 5. 'Considered by Paul not to disclose or already disclosed' – the files were dropped into this folder if in my view they were not relevant to the Inquiry. When the review process finished there were 241 files in this Folder.
- vii. I then went back into Folder 5 and reviewed the documents. This involved sending the policy to myself electronically with an exhibit number, editing the output from CoPilot (if required), for example to remove irrelevant information; attaching an exhibit number and check the output against the relevant policy / procedure / document to ensure the page referencing was correct and the required information was recorded in the document. And finally, on

some occasions, where there was no engagement I recorded why the policy was being disclosed. This output was then recorded as an exhibit. There were 48 such exhibits.

- 6.8 As per Section 5, to achieve the objective of the Request two tables were formulated (Table 1 – NGPF0010684 and Table 2 – NGPF0010685). These tables indicate which policy engaged which requirement. These tables identify the Policy / Procedure already disclosed and the engagement against a – g(ii). NGPF0010684 covers a to d; and NGPF0010685 covers e to g(ii).
- 6.9 To achieve the objective of the Annex Paragraph 4, of the Nottingham Inquiry letter dated 30 January 2026, this statement goes onto explain the extent to which the matters set out are covered by policies, procedures or documents that Nottinghamshire Police have already disclosed to the Inquiry. This detail is recorded in Section 7 beside the relevant exhibit number.
- 6.10 A second set of tables (Tables 3 - NGPF0010686 and 4 - NGPF0010687), outline which of the previously undisclosed policies engages which of the areas set out in Paragraph 3.1. NGPF0010686 covers a to d; and NGPF0010687 covers e to g(ii).

- 6.11 To achieve the objective of the Request, the Policies/Procedures that I determined needed disclosure are allocated an exhibit number as per the established naming conventions.
- 6.12 It should again be noted that some policies were reported as Not Engaged – however common sense and my knowledge of policies and procedures indicated that disclosure should take place. In this instance the specific exhibit is recorded as such with annotation to this effect.
- 6.13. A third set of tables (Table 5 - NGPF0010688 and Table 6 - NGPF0010689), outline which of the previously undisclosed policies written separately by CTP East Midlands and the East Midlands Special Operations Unit engaged which of the areas set out in Paragraph 3.1. NGPF0010688 covers a to d; and NGPF0010689 covers e to g(ii). Section 9 outlines the detail of the engagement.
- 6.14 To achieve the objective of the Request, the documents that I determined needed disclosure, are allocated an exhibit number as per the established naming conventions.

- 7 Policy, Procedure and Document coverage Exhibit**
