THE NOTTINGHAM INQUIRY

FIRST WITNESS STATEMENT OF DC ASIF STEVENS-GARRIB

I, Asif Stevens-Garrib, of Nottinghamshire Police will say as follows:-

INTRODUCTION

1. This witness statement is made to assist the Nottingham Inquiry (The "Inquiry") with the matters set out in the Rule 9 Request dated 14 March 2026 (The "Request").
2. I am a Detective Constable of Nottinghamshire Police with close to 23 years' service. My current role is that of a mentor on the Domestic Abuse Team within the Public Protection Department. I provide investigation support and assistance to civilian investigators and police officers.

3. I have been a Detective Constable for 15 years and have previously worked within both the Criminal Investigation Department (CID), Public Protection Departments, and the Major Crime Unit between 2010-2024. I have experience in complex, protracted criminal investigations that include violence against the person offences, serious sexual offences and murder.
4. Between 2018-2024 I was a Detective on the Major Crime Unit (MCU); an East Midlands regional investigation team whose primary remit is murder investigations. During my tenure I helped develop an investigative role referred to as CCTV Co-ordinator. This role involves being responsible for the recovery, review, and disclosure of CCTV material together with its presentation at Court. I have been the lead CCTV Co-ordinator in multiple Major Crime investigations and have also assisted other CCTV Co-ordinators.
5. I was the CCTV Co-ordinator for Operation Hendrix, which was an MCU investigation into events that took place during the morning of Tuesday the 13th of June 2023.
6. I have been asked to provide information concerning the seven individuals captured on CCTV walking past a location on Ilkeston Road where VC was waiting for half an hour. The term "half an hour" refers to a time period of 03:30:46 to 04:00:29 on Tuesday the 13th of June 2023; a total of 29 minutes, 43 seconds.

7. 03:30:46 records the last sighting of VC prior to the attacks on Barnaby Webber and Grace O'Malley-Kumar. This sighting is captured on CCTV data referred to as Police Item CA140623-1120, recovered from a business premises located on Middleton Street.

8. The relevant camera is an external static camera providing a downward view along Middleton Street towards Middleton Street / Ilkeston Road Junction; the full width of the junction can be seen. Beyond the junction, a section of Ilkeston Road is visible running horizontally between building lines that border each side of the junction. Beyond this, a far side section of pavement is visible. The time stamp is also visible on screen. Directly behind the first digit of 2023 [2], a keep left bollard is visible, located on the midway reservation of a pedestrian crossing. Due to limited lighting, the CCTV infra-red setting is active. The footage has the appearance of black & white / greyscale video. The footage is of sufficient quality to distinguish tonal differences between items of clothing worn by individuals recorded. It is also possible to determine lone individuals and groups of individuals. A system time check was completed at the point of recovery - The CCTV system time was recorded as being 10 seconds slow when compared against real / live time. I will refer to this CCTV and Camera point of view as "Camera View A".

9. 04:00:29 records the first sighting of VC approaching Barnaby Webber and Grace O'Malley-Kumar on Ilkeston Road. This moment in time is captured on CCTV data referred to as Police Item KPR-4, recovered from a pizza take-away business located on Ilkeston Road. An internal static camera provides a

restricted view of the far side pavement of Ilkeston Road. Due to limited lighting, the CCTV infra-red setting is active. The footage has the appearance of black & white / greyscale video. A system time check was completed at the point of recovery; the CCTV system time was recorded as being 49 minutes 12 seconds fast when compared against real / live time. I will refer to this CCTV and Camera point of view as "Camera View B".

10. Between Camera View A and Camera View B there is an area of Ilkeston Road that has no CCTV coverage. This area is highlighted on Page 23 of Police Item ASG-507 - CCTV Sequence of Events Document v.2 [NGPF0010192]. It is within this area VC was present between 03:30:46 and 04:00:29 on Tuesday the 13th of June 2023. I will refer to this section of Ilkeston Road as "Area 1"

11. 314 Ilkeston Road is located on the same side of Ilkeston Road as Area 1. CCTV data recovered from this address is referred to as Police Item PO-1. A single external static camera provides a wide section view of Ilkeston Road together with views of the pavement running parallel along each side of Ilkeston Road. The recovered footage is of good quality allowing for persons and vehicles to be clearly seen. A system time check was completed at the point of recovery. The CCTV system time was recorded as being 1 hour slow when compared against real / live time. I will refer to this CCTV and Camera point of view as "Camera View C".

12. Camera View A and Camera View C are located either side of Area 1. This means that individuals walking through Camera View A towards and into Camera View C would pass Area 1. Individuals walking through Camera View C towards and into Camera View A would pass Area 1. To assist in recording individuals walking past Area 1 between 03:30:46 to 04:00:29 on Tuesday the 13th of June 2023, I have used Camera View A and Camera View C only. I have recorded each sighting separately from start to finish. All timings are recorded in Real Time [RT].

13. Camera View A shows at 03:32:37 to 03:32:46 a lone adult male [M1] coming into view from right to left. He crosses Middleton Street / Ilkeston Road junction and continues along the nearside pavement towards Camera View C and out of view. I would describe M1 as wearing a mid tone short sleeve top, dark tone trousers, light tone footwear. He is shown to be carrying a light tone carrier bag. Camera View C shows at 03:33:12 to 03:33:45 M1 coming into view from left to right along the far side of the pavement and then out of view. The direction of travel completed by M1 supports that he has walked past Area 1 albeit along the opposite side pavement.

14. Camera View C shows at 03:34:12 to 03:34:30 two adult males [M2] & [M3] coming into view from right to left walking side-by-side on the nearside pavement (same side as Area 1). Both continue together along the nearside pavement towards Area 1 and Camera View A. M2 - Wearing short sleeve dark tone top, dark tone trousers, mid tone footwear, and a dark tone

rucksack style bag worn over the shoulder / shoulders. I would describe M2 as a Black Male, 5'10-6'00 tall, slim to medium build, aged 18 to 24 years. I would describe M3 as wearing a mid tone hooded top with hood worn up over head, dark tone shorts, prominent light tone socks and dark tone footwear. M3 was a Black Male, 6'00-6'02 tall, medium build, aged 18 to 24 years.

15. Camera View A shows at 03:35:36 to 03:35:53 M2 and M3 coming into view from left to right along the far side pavement on Ilkeston Road and then out of view. The direction of travel completed by M2 and M3 supports that they have walked past Area 1.

16. Camera View A shows at 03:34:48 to 03:35:02 a lone adult male [M4] coming into view from right to left along the far side pavement on Ilkeston Road, towards Area 1 and Camera View C. I would describe M4 as wearing dark tone clothing and dark footwear. Camera View C shows at 03:35:39 to 03:35:54 M4 coming into view from left to right along the nearside pavement on Ilkeston Road (same side as Area 1) and right turn into an alleyway located between 314 and 316 Ilkeston Road and then out of view. I would describe M4 as a mixed race / Asian male, 5'10-6'00 tall, slim build, aged 25-30 years. He can be seen to be carrying a holdall style bag in his right hand. The direction of travel completed by M4 supports that he has walked past Area 1.

17. Camera View A shows at 03:38:38 to- 03:38:48 a lone adult male [M5] coming into view from right to left. He crosses Middleton Street / Ilkeston Road junction and continues along the nearside pavement towards Camera View C

and out of view. I would describe M5 as wearing dark tone clothing and dark footwear with light tone soles. Camera View C between 03:39:27 to 03:40:04 shows M5 coming into view from left to right along the far side of the pavement and out of view. M5 is a white male, 6'00-6'02 tall, medium build, aged 20-25 years. The direction of travel completed by M5 supports that he has walked past Area 1 albeit along the opposite side pavement.

18. Camera View A between 03:51:15 to - 03:51:33 shows a lone adult male [M6] coming into view from right to left along the far side pavement on Ilkeston Road towards Area 1 and Camera View C. I would describe M6 as wearing dark tone clothing with a hood to upper outer clothing. Camera View C between 03:52:20 to 03:52:37 shows M6 coming into view from left to right along the nearside pavement on Ilkeston Road (same side as Area 1) and then out of view. M6 was a black male, 5'10-6'00 tall, slim build, aged 18-24 years. The direction of travel completed by M6 supports that he has walked past Area 1.

19. Camera View A between 03:52:12 to 03:52:22 shows a lone adult male [M7] coming into view from right to left. He crosses Middleton Street / Ilkeston Road junction and continues along the nearside pavement towards Camera View C and then out of view. I would describe M7 as wearing dark tone short sleeve top and trousers, dark tone footwear with light tone sole. Camera View C between 03:52:52 to 03:53:28 shows M7 coming into view from left to right along the far side of the pavement and then out of view. M7 was a white male,

5'10-6'00 tall, slim build, aged 20-25. The direction of travel completed by M7 supports that he has walked past Area 1 albeit along the opposite side pavement.

20. Camera View C between 04:00:10 to 04:00:44 shows a lone adult male [M8] coming into view walking along the far side pavement of Ilkeston Road from right to left towards Camera View A and then out of view. M8 was a Black male, 6'00-6'02 tall, medium build, aged 25-30 years. M8 was wearing a mid-tone long sleeve top, dark tone trousers, dark tone footwear, and a mid-tone rucksack worn over the shoulders.

21. Camera View A between 04:00:10 to 04:00:30 shows Barnaby Webber and Grace O'Malley-Kumar coming into view from right to left along the far side of pavement on Ilkeston Road, walking towards Area 1 and out of view.

22. Camera View A between 04:01:10 to 04:01:18 shows M8 coming into view from left to right running along the far side pavement on Ilkeston Road and out of view. The direction of travel completed by M8 supports that he has walked past Area 1.
